Emergency Care Instructions

In the event of a medical emergency under the care of Kitty Kisses Concierge, emergency services (such as a veterinary clinic or emergency/critical care facility) may request instructions regarding your resuscitation preferences.

This form allows you, the pet owner, to indicate your wishes so that Kitty Kisses Concierge, LLC may communicate to emergency veterinary staff to act in accordance with your instructions.

Understanding Your Options

1. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

- CPR includes chest compressions, assisted breathing, and other emergency measures intended to restart your cat's heart or breathing.
- While performed with care and urgency, the success rate of CPR in cats is low, even in hospital settings.
- Cats that do recover may require intensive care and could experience complications afterward.

2. Do Not Resuscitate (DNR)

- Choosing "Do Not Resuscitate" means you request that no CPR or resuscitation efforts be performed if your cat's heart or breathing stops.
- Comfort measures (such as gentle handling, minimizing distress and pain) will still be provided.
